I am very excited to be hosting this year's Ladies Events at the convention and am looking forward to seeing everyone in June. There are a few things I want to make sure I share with everyone who is planning on coming so proper preparations can be made. Please refer to the convention schedule for more details on dates and times.

First, my very talented friend Kim Sogn will be visiting us at the hotel on Thursday afternoon for a floral arrangement class. Kim is the owner of The Garden Shed Floral here in Canton and she is an amazing florist. We are still finalizing the details of what type of arrangement we will be making, but I know whatever it is will be fabulous. If you plan on attending this event, please RSVP to me by May 25th, as that will give Kim enough time to prepare her materials and supplies.

On Friday, I will have transportation planned for us and we will head to downtown Sioux Falls for lunch, some shopping, and – what I am most excited for – a Sip N Cycle ride through downtown Sioux Falls! If you are unfamiliar with Sip N Cycle, here is more information:

Party Bike Sioux Falls is the only authorized Pedal Pub Party Bike operator in the state of South Dakota! We now have three bikes in operation in Sioux Falls. The bike, created in the Netherlands and shipped across the sea, seats sixteen people and moves at a leisurely 4-5 mph. Ten of the seats have pedals, two without, three on the bench, and there is room for one more in the middle with the coolers! Party Bike Sioux Falls launched in 2014 and is owned by Army National Guard Veterans Patrick Jones, Brian Anderson, and Matt Aanenson.

And don't worry, if you don't want to pedal, there are a few seats where that isn't required. We are allowed to bring coolers on board with us, so we'll bring a variation of beverages. Beer and wine IS allowed as long as it is not in glass containers. A driver will guide the bike throughout the tour and can bring us wherever we would like in the downtown area.

A few **VERY IMPORTANT** details about the Sip N Cycle: 1) If you plan on riding with us, please make sure to **RSVP to me as soon as possible** so I'll know if we need to book more than one bike. 2) All participants must be over the age of 18 with a valid ID. Passengers without a valid ID <u>will not</u> be allowed to ride, per insurance purposes. A liability waiver form will need to be signed by everyone before riding.


